- Quilts of Valor = 2
- Area Agency on Aging (not including Christmas quilts) = 21
- Area Agency on Aging (Christmas only) = 83
- Miracle Farms = 6
- Graduating Seniors at Still Creek Ranch = 4
- Quilts for misc. donations = 14

In addition to the guilts, Quilt 'n Peace provided 8 walker totes to the Area Agency on Aging.
